In January 1939, a group of visionary teachers from Seattle banded together to form an organization to make simple, dignified, economical funeral options available to the general public.

They named it PEOPLE'S MEMORIAL ASSOCIATION. Little did they know how they would revolutionize funeral care.

In 1939 the cremation rate in Washington State was less than one percent. Seventy-five years later it is almost 80% who choose cremation. The end-of-life planning workshop sponsored by PEOPLE'S MEMORIAL Education Fund, "Got Your Ducks in a Row?" has been very well received! We continue to host these and more will be scheduled this Spring and Fall.

The "Ducks" workshop includes information from an estate planning attorney, a spokesperson from Compassion & Choices of WA reviewing the Death With Dignity Law and Advanced Directives, along with a presentation by PEOPLE'S MEMORIAL on funeral directives and decisions about body disposition. There are many handouts to help you make decisions that are right for you.

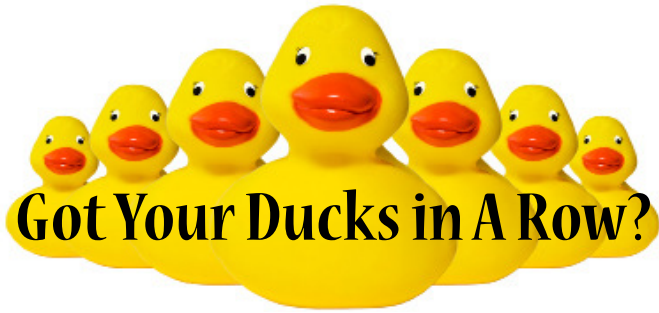

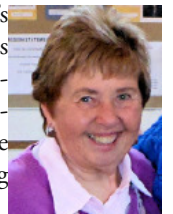
Nominating Committee (1 year term):
